- Length of the research paper must be in 3000 words.
- The article/research paper without references or incomplete references will not be entertained. References should be written as per the APA Style Manual.
- The article/research paper should be accompanied with a declaration to the effect that the paper is the original work of the author and that has not been submitted for publication anywhere else.
- All contribution should also include (i) Name of the Author (ii) their professional affiliation (iii) postal address (iv) phone/mobile number & email.
