## RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS OF 'e-SSAY'

- The event 'e-SSAY', an essay competition, is only for Indian students (both UG and PG) studying on any branches of Science/ Engineering/ Humanities.
- Any essay should be written by a single student or by two students. However, a student can submit more than one essay.
- The broad topic of the event 'e-SSAY' is 'COVID-19 and its Impact from an Indian Perspective'. Any submitted write-up which is not within this scope will not be considered for the event 'e-SSAY'.
- A student should consider at least one subtopic mentioned above. The write-up should be original and must not be directly copied from one or two particular research works/books/scientific reports.
- The submission of the essay is purely through online. Students are hereby requested to fill-up the form <u>https://forms.gle/dNaR3JfegBnx2QQv7</u> and upload the write-up on or before 31st July 2020. No hardcopy is required.
- It is preferable to use word/latex to prepare the essay write-up. For preparing the essay writing in word file, Times New Roman with single column-12 font is preferable. However, in the absence of a computer, the essay for competition can be written on a single side of a plain paper. In this case, the dissertation can be submitted after taking a clear picture of the pages serially (preferably use Adobe Scan/Clear Scan/Microsoft Office Lens-PDF Scanner) and then make a pdf. The maximum word limit is 2000.
- There are attractive prizes for the best three essays. Moreover, there will be five more consolation prizes. The selected articles may be published in an edited book/journal. Every participant will receive an e-certificate.
- There will be a panel of experts from various institutions and the decision of this panel will be final.
